

of which was for a women high class (Nordahl 1984). Gamla Uppsala was now entering its peak as a pagan cult centre. The actions of Anund finally led to a resistance to Christianity that was to last here for another three hundred years.

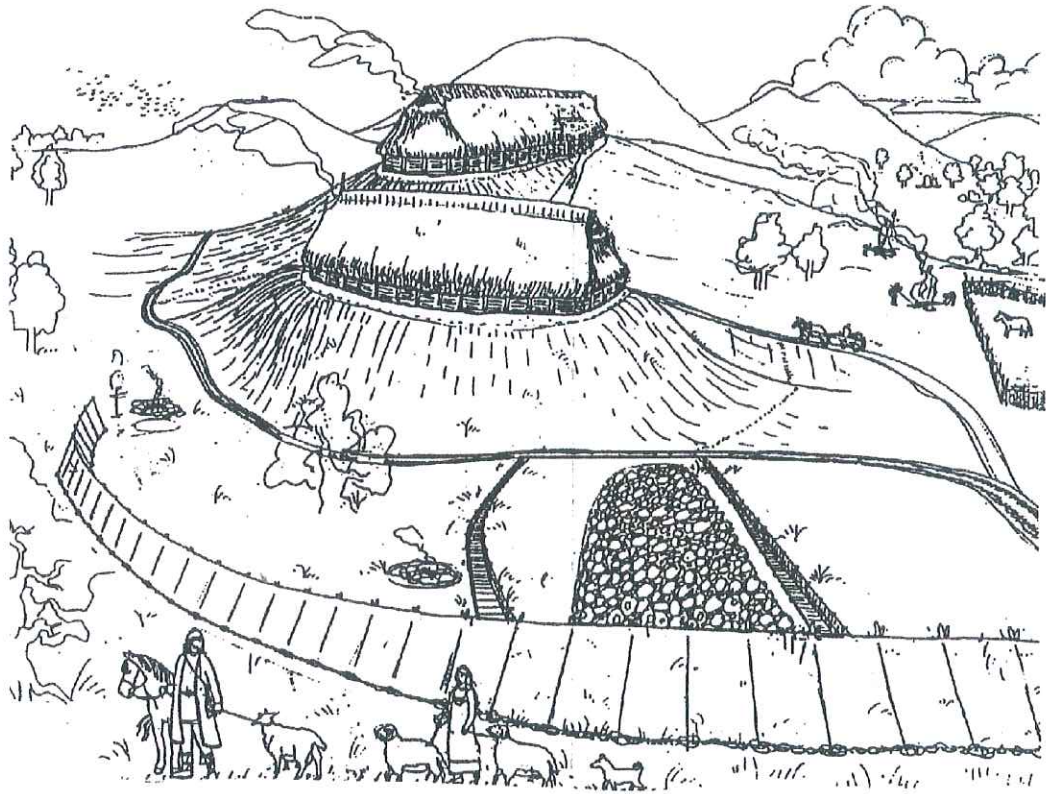


Figure 3: Reconstructive drawing of Gamla Uppsala's Royal Demesne at the beginning of the 800s. The nearest (northern plateau) hall has not yet been excavated and the true extent of these king's lands is not as yet known (Duczko 1996).
